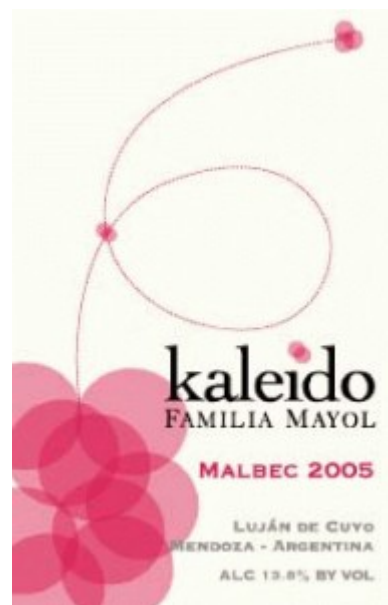

TASTING NOTES Balanced, completely mature. Intense red-violet color. Blueberry, mineral notes and fresh acidity keeps it mouthwateringly fresh. Sweet tannins blended with oak provide complexity and a velvety and long finish.

WINERY INFO The Mayol family has three estate vineyards, all between 3100 to 4000 ft. above sea level. Pedro Juan Mayol, a Spanish immigrant to Argentina, was a grape grower in the early nineteen hundreds and today his family carries on the tradition. They believe in showing the character of each of their unique vineyards by producing single-vineyard wines in limited quantity. They recently began to work with Steve Clifton of Palmina and Brewer-Clifton fame from Santa Barbara, California.
